



PUBLIC LECTURESHIP AND WHITE PAPER COMPETITION, 2023- 2024

1. Complete the **Cover Sheet** including broad problem to be addressed and proposal title.
2. Prepare a **Proposal** that addresses questions a-d below. Allocate a separate section to each question, limiting total length to 5 double-spaced pages:
 - a. What is the specific policy question (Promoting Environmental Justice OR Creating a More Functional Democracy) that your proposed Lecture and White Paper will address?
 - b. How (by way of background, prior research, policy experience, or other factors) are you particularly qualified to address this issue? Include a list of up to five relevant publications.
 - c. In the proposed 5000 word White Paper, what approaches will you take in addressing the questions? Specifically, how will you integrate existing, high-quality published evidence (including, if relevant, cross-state comparisons) with your own original theoretical or empirical work to generate policy recommendations that are credible, defensible, and acceptable to the public?
 - d. How do you plan to manage your collaboration? Who will be responsible for which aspects of the work? How will this collaboration help to achieve the goals of the UC President's Grow Your Own Initiative ([Growing our own: Developing a faculty that reflects California | University of California](#)). If there is evidence of prior successful collaboration between the two members of the team, please share.
3. Include an abbreviated **CV or Biosketch** of no more than two pages for both the faculty PI and collaborating trainee (graduate student or professional student or post-doc) listed as the co-PI.
4. Include a **Budget** with estimated expenses (up to \$25,000). Approved expenses include: personnel (graduate student support and/or undergraduate research student assistant support), up to \$5K of PI self-support or summer salary if allowable within your home campus' guidelines, miscellaneous research expenses – supplies, printing, graphic design, etc (no laptops or computers), and travel to UC Center Sacramento for the May/June talk.
5. Send the completed Cover Sheet, Proposal, CVs/Biosketches, and Budget as attachments to an email addressed to uccsbaconlectureship@ucdavis.edu no later than midnight on Thursday, November 16, 2023.
6. The White Paper deadline is Thursday, April 4, 2024 and should you receive the award you need to be available to do a public lecture to a Sacramento policy audience in May 2024 or June 2024.
